## Fight for Freedom - A Curse Turned into Blessing



About two month ago the Eastern Orthodox Church in Moldova indicated that it will push to introduce a subject on “Foundation of Eastern Orthodoxy” to all public school as mandatory. This would mean an outright brain-washing of children and eventual discrimination and persecution of all other religions including with a special focus on Evangelical Church. We have signed a joint letter from Evangelical Churches of Moldova (representing about 4% or population) addressed to the president and prime-ministry of the country expressing our concern and suggestions. This week the parliament has passed a law allowing religious education as optional at all school which will actually open a door for us to teach the Bible in public schools. The Lord can sure turn a bad situation into a blessing. But we know the fight is not over. Please pray for the Lord’s leading, for wisdom and boldness for us and other leaders of Evangelical denominations.

## Outreach in Ceadir-Lunga, Gagauz



Yurii Topal, a graduate of Moldova Bible Seminary, serves as a church planter in the south of Moldova. Yurii, formerly a lawyer, is leading this dynamic ministry since 2005. He remodeled his apartment creating a counseling center downtown Ceadir-Lubnga. People passing from the town open market are able to just walk in and ask for help where Yurii shares the gospel with them.

This June a team from Fielder Road Baptist Church (Texas) came to help with the evangelism efforts in this Turkish speaking town. The team served through food distribution, street evangelism, and VBS.



Yura’s ministry is on of the partner ministries with KBC. Please pray for the Lord to direct a partner church in USA that would be interested in two-three year ministry partnership and would be open to providing some financial support for Yurii’s congregation and family.
