On May 26th we had an honor to be a part of the **ninth graduation of Moldova Bible Seminary**. It was a long road and a great victory. July has been accepted to minister with Campus Crusade for Christ, Alina serves at Crisis Pregnancy Center, Serghei is a youth pastor and the leader of the team that went to serve in Kirgizstan, Natasha serves at a church in Transnistria, Olga is a children minister at her home church, Natasha and her husband serve as missionaries helping send other to the mission field in Russia.

The first week of July we took part in **the evangelistic youth camp** with over fifty unbelieving teenagers. As the result at least half of the came to know the Lord as their Savior, Lord, and Friend. The camp was organized with Scottsdale Bible Church mission team. The teenagers came are still part of our ministry. Our church youth ministry regularly has meetings and sports event for these youth. It has been a great experience that proved to be an effective tool for evangelism. Now we pray for next year opportunities to conduct two similar camps.



Team of four seminary students and graduate spent almost fifty days in Central Asia **working among the Dungan people**. They came and served with their hands as well as with their lives. They stayed in homes of the villagers and had many opportunities to share the Gospel. This year they have seen a decision for Christ and have shared that many are ready to follow the Lord, but afraid of the reactions of their families and fellow villagers. Please be in prayer for these people as well as for the continuation of ministry in Central Asia.

In the end of May a small team from KOST Evangelical Free Church (MN) came to serve with us. The team was led by Rev. Tom Mason who taught a class on Gospel of Mark at Moldova Bible Seminary and a series of marriage seminars. The team had a chance to **share the Gospel of the streets**, deliver food to low-income families, speak at a few churches and develop a vision for more ministry in the future. Two of the team members have firefighting background and since they returned home they are actively working on putting together a ministry to firefighters in Moldova.



In June the partnership with Fannin Terrace Baptist Church led us to an **Urban Inner-City Sports Camp**. The team joined by the members of Kishinev Bible Church has ministered to kids through Soccer, Volleyball, and Basketball. It allowed for relationships to be built and the gospel shared. Several kids who were part of this outreach in another location came this time and gave their lives to Christ.



VILLAGE CHURCHES



In a village about twenty five miles outside of the capital there is a small group of believers gathering together every Sunday to study the Word of God. They are led by a layman. Bro. Semion is a builder who came to know the Lord a few years ago through the ministry of Kishinev Bible Church. He and his family were a great blessing.



For years our church tried to start a ministry in the village of Cojushna, but the hearts of people were hard and even though people would listen to the Gospel they would not commit to following Christ. After two unsuccessful attempts to start a church there and missionaries moving on after couple month of ministry we decided to move on. But the Lord had other plans. He took a man with no seminary education and brought men and women to his home who wanted to hear more about God. After a while they became a small church led by Semion who would teach them lessons he would pickup from sermons and Bible studies he attended himself. In the spring a small team from Kost Evangelical Free Church came to visit and encourage the small church. This group is part of the plan to fill the country of Moldova with Christ's gospel. The strategy includes planting two point-churches in the North and South of the country. We invite you to join us in pray for those new church plant and missionary families who will be planting those churches. Also please be in prayer for Semion and a the small body of believers in Cojushna. Pray for Semions' spiritual growth, his family and strength in leading and teaching. Semion would like to get more education, but has a little time between the ministry and the job. Please pray for wise decisions for Semion.
